UPHA CLASSICS offered for ASB fine harness, 3 gaited, 5 gaited, and park pleasure 3 year olds.

Horse show requirements & prize money distribution: The Horse Show hosting a UPHA Classic shall provide a trophy and six ribbons to distribute to the entries. Any horse show wishing to host a Classic must submit a request to the UPHA Office at least 30 days prior to the class. The horse show will receive a result sheet for each class it hosts, and these results sheets must be completed and returned to the UPHA Office within 10 days following the close of the show.

The entry fee for all UPHA Classic classes is \$100 regardless of the amount of Added Money offered.

Prize money should be distributed as soon as possible, but no later than 30 days after the conclusion of the Classic. It is recommended that adequate time be allowed to be sure that all entry checks have cleared before the prize money is disbursed.

All monies collected in each Classic will be dispersed in that class. Prize money in a \$500 or \$1000 Added Money Classic is divided as follows: \$300 is deducted from the total, with \$100 going to fourth, fifth and sixth places. Of the balance, 50% is paid to first place, 30% to second place, and 20% to third place. If there were only 2 entries, the total prize money would be split 60% and 40%. If only 3 entries show, the original percentages would apply without the \$300 deduction. In case of only one entry, that entry would receive 100% of the total. Prize money in a \$250 Added Money Classic would be broken down in the same percentages as the other UPHA Classic classes, however, only \$50 would be awarded to the fourth, fifth, and sixth place.

4. CAMPER: \$20 a night

5. STALL FEES: Stalls are constructed of wood, cement block, or a combination of steel pipe and wood. 10 X10 and larger Tie stalls are wood 4'X6'. One bale of straw per horse stall will be provided when shavings are not used as bedding.

6. CHAMPIONSHIPS: Entries must have been entered, shown and judged in any class in the division. The first three ribbon winners (see division for forceback classes) are required to show back or forfeit their winnings.

All prize money will be stapled to ribbons except force backs, which will be given at time of entry into the championship.

8. HOLDING OF CLASSES: Only exhibitors who have back-to-back classes may request a 2 minute hold. Request forms are available in the horse show office and **must be made one hour before the session in which the conflict occurs.**

9. REFUNDS: No refund on canceled entries & stalls after closing date. Refund on entries fees only with a Vets certificate.

10. INDEBTEDNESS: Any indebtedness to this show will result in the return of entries & the points of the individual member causing the debt will be withheld until the debt is paid in full. Future entries will be refused.

11. CHANGES: The show committee welcomes suggestions for the show, however; due to schedule and time constraints, we are not able to add or change classes after January 1st.

12. RING PROCEDURE AND CONDUCT: A maximum of 2 minutes to enter the ring after the class is called and the first entrant is in the ring will be allowed

13. PROTESTS & COMPLAINTS: Will be handled by a committee designated by the show chairman

14. COURTESY TO OFFICIALS & EXHIBITORS: The Twin Rivers Horse Show reserves the right to eliminate from further competition any individual(s) who are disrespectful to officials or exhibitors and such individuals shall forfeit all premiums they have won and entry and stall fees they have paid.
